eighteen hundred and twenty one duly executed acknowledged and recorded in
Liber W. G. N. 2 folio 35 & one of the personal deed record books of Anne Arundel
County did for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and seventy five
dollars did grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert B. Moss his executors
administrators and assigns with legal heirs and assigns forever the above
mentioned premises being tract or parcels of land above recited deed of
Mortgage well known fully and at large appear. And whereas the said Benjamin
F. Weedon hath fully paid and satisfied unto the said Robert B. Moss the above
mentioned sum of money and the interest thereon both the said Robert B. Moss doth
agree to execute this instrument of writing as a full release of the above mentioned
property Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Robert B. Moss
for and in consideration of the payment of the above mentioned sum of money
and the interest thereon and for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar
lawful money to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin F. Weedon the receipt
whereof the said Robert B. Moss doth acknowledge to be fully satisfied contented
and paid both and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell release
release and confirm unto the said Benjamin F. Weedon his heirs and assigns for
ever the above mentioned Negro boy John to the use of the said Benjamin F. Weedon
and assigns to him and his assigns to and for no other use intent or
purpose whatever In Witness whereof the said Robert B. Moss hath hereunto
