 and will lawfully and forever defend by these presents. Provided nevertheless
 that in case the said Thomas W. Stinchcomb shall pay and satisfy to the said
 James Sylehart or to his Executors administrators or assigns the sum of fifty
 four dollars and forty two Cents money with Interest for the same on or before
 the first day of October next ensuing then this bill of sale and every matter and
 thing therein expressed shall be void and of none effect, at being the true intent
 and meaning thereof that the said dove gelding, the crop growing in the ground and
 the bees and honey are mortgaged by me the said Thomas W. Stinchcomb
 to secure to the said James Sylehart the payment of the money aforesaid. In
