 the said described property against every Executors and administrators, and
 against all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any

This Indenture made this second day of June in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three Between George W Gray
 of Anne Arundel County Maryland of the one part and Joshua Gray of the
 same place of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said George W
 Gray stands indebted to the Joshua Gray in the full and just sum of one
 hundred and fifty seven dollars with interest. And the said Joshua Gray
 is also bound as security for the payment of considerable sums of money due
 to various Creditors by the said George W Gray and to secure the payment
 of the said sum of one hundred and fifty seven dollars with interest and
 also to save and indemnify the said Joshua Gray against all loss by reason
 of said security ships, the said George W Gray is willing to execute these
 presents. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said George W Gray
 for and in consideration of the premises and for and in consideration of the
 further sum of one dollar current money to him in hand paid by the said
 Joshua Gray at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
 receipt whereof the said Joshua Gray doth hereby acknowledge by these
 presents.
