Know all Men by these Presents that I Joseph Speed of Baltimore City in the State of Maryland for and in Consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by George T Dilly of Anne Arundel County in the said State before the sealing of these presents have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said George T Dilly one negro woman named Mary who was aged fourteen years on the Eleventh day of December Eighteen hundred and thirty one and who has to serve until she arrives at the age of thirty one years also her male Child named Chooer age do. about six years and her female Child named Lucy aged near two years both of which Children are slaves for life To have and To hold the said described negro woman Mary for the term aforesaid and the said described Negroes Chooer & Lucy for their lives unto the said George T Dilly his heirs Executors administrators and assigns and to the said Joseph Speed for himself his heirs Executors & administrators the said Negroes Mary Chooer & Lucy unto the said George T Dilly his Executors administrators and assigns against him the said Joseph Speed his Executors administrators and assigns against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and well warrant and forever defend by these presents and the said George T Dilly doth covenant that he his Executors administrators and assigns will at the end of the term aforesaid permit the said Mary to go free In Witness Whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals the Eighteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty nine
