

sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Alexander Lewis his Executors administrators and assigns all the growing crops now standing upon the land and premises whereon the said Fielder Lewis now resides consisting of Indian corn Tobacco, water Melons, Cantalopes, Potatoes and every species of vegetables and other crops which are now growing in and upon the premises of the said Fielder Lewis all and singular which said crops and other the premises are now remaining in possession and occupation of the said Fielder Lewis To have and to hold all and singular the said crops as above mentioned and other the premises above mentioned and sold or mentioned or intended to be sold to the said Alexander Lewis his Executors administrators and assigns forever And the said Fielder Lewis for myself my heirs Executors and administrators all and singular the said crops and other the premises above mentioned unto the said Alexander Lewis his Executors administrators and assigns against and the said Fielder Lewis my Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons who hereunto shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents of all and singular the said crops and other the premises The said Fielder Lewis have put the said Alexander Lewis in full possession by delivering to him the said Alexander Lewis the whole of the crops and premises as aforesaid at the sealing and delivering of these presents in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be sold unto him the said Alexander Lewis his heirs and assigns forever In Witness whereof the said Fielder Lewis have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this nineteenth day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty three
