

by Benjamin Worthington a free man of colour of the County and State aforesaid has granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Worthington a Negro boy named Elias and aged about three years To have and To hold the aforesaid boy so described as aforesaid to him the said Benjamin Worthington Executors administrators and assigns against the my Executors administrators and assigns forever In Witness whereof I the said Vachel Lewis have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of August eighteen hundred and forty three

At the fact of the aforesaid was thus indented to wit

Maryland To Be Remembered That on this fifteenth day of August eighteen hundred and forty three personally appeared before me the undersigned a Justice of the peace of the County and State aforesaid the aforesaid Vachel Lewis and he acknowledged the foregoing instrument of writing to him he has not and did for the purpose therein mentioned In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this day and year first aforesaid at Acknowledged J W Hunter

Know all men by these presents that I Juliana Hammond widow of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars some money of the United States in hand paid by Evan S Ellicott, Andrew Ellicott & Elias Ellicott trading under the firm of E S Ellicott & Co. of the City of Baltimore and State aforesaid and the further consideration of having received from the said E S Ellicott & Co. their three certain promissory notes each bearing date with the day of the date hereof one of said notes payable thirty days after date for fifty dollars and other of said notes payable six months after date for two hundred and fifty dollars, and one other of said notes payable twelve months after date for two hundred and fifty dollars at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the purport whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Evan S Ellicott & Co. their Executors administrators and assigns Two thousand boards of oak wood Standing on Hammonds six concessions in Anne Arundel County State aforesaid at forty cents per board the same to be cut clean except the Chesnut which is to be left standing with the right to cut and remove the same, or should the said E S Ellicott & Co. desire to their advantage they are at liberty to take the pine wood of standing on said land
