 and administrators each to the other his her or their Executors and administrators  
 withdrawn of sixteen hundred dollars Is in testimony whereof they have hereunto

 hundred and forty three

 hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered and by  
 these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Thomas  
 J Terry the negro boy named Washington now eleven years of age  
 which said negro boy Washington belonged to the aforesaid Sarah Ann  
 Terry being a servant for a term of years, which said negro boy Washington  
 I will warrant and defend to the said Thomas J Terry his Executors  
 administrators and assigns to serve him the said Thomas J Terry until  
 the nineteenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and sixty  
 when his term of servitude will expire against all persons whomsoever  
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this seventh  
 day of September one thousand eight hundred and forty three
