 performance of the several covenants and agreements aforesaid the parties
 aforesaid do hereby respectively bind themselves and their respective heirs Executors
 and administrators each to the other his her or their Executors and administrators

 administrators and assigns to serve him the said Thomas J. Terry until
 the nineteenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and sixty
 when his term of servitude will expire against all persons whomsoever. In
