This Indenture made this eighteenth day of September in the year of our Lord eight hundred and forty three Between Benjamin W<sup>m</sup> Tucker of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland of the one part and John F. Wilson of the said County and State on the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars current money paid to the said Tucker by the said Wilson for which sum of one hundred and twenty dollars the said Tucker stands justly indebted and to secure the payment of said sum to said Wilson the said Tucker doth hereby bargain sell and convey unto said J. F. Wilson one bay mare, one gray horse armed bow, and red kiff and one calf and the said Tucker doth hereby agree that the said Wilson may take into his possession for his own use and benefit or may sell here out or otherwise dispose of for the purpose of making the aforesaid sum of money that he may see fit and right in the premises and for no other purpose In Testimony of which the said Benjamin W<sup>m</sup> Tucker hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this date and year first above written.
