Provided always and these presents are upon this condition that if the said John Miller his Executors & Administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said William Sewell Administrator as aforesaid or his assigns the full sum of one thousand one hundred Poundsly dollars current money with legal interest for the same or before the first day of October in the year eighteen hundred and forty seven then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing herein contained shall cease determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding. Gosnell of Anne Arundel County payment of certain sums of money now due and owing from me to the said Battle & Lowe and to the said Charity G. Gosnell and in consideration of the sum of One dollar current money to and now hand paid by the said Battle & Lowe at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents and the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold assigned transferred and set over and by these presents do bargain and sell assign transfer and set over unto the said Battle & Lowe their Executors Administrators and assigns all my crops of Tobacco when born and other grains now growing or being on my farm in Anne Arundel County in and near the said Baltimore and to hold the aforesaid crops unto and to the use of the said Battle & Lowe
