 and thirdly to the payment of such further sums of money as may become due and
 owing from me to them or either of them at any time prior to the Execution of the
 aforesaid previous trusts And lastly as to any surplus to pay the same over unto
 my Executors administrators or assigns In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and seal this sixteenth day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and
 forty three

 that the said James Swinmore Jun^r for and in consideration of the premises
 and for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars current money to him
 in hand paid by the said James Iglehart at or before the sealing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge. Shall
 grant bargain and sell and by these presents doth grant bargain
 and sell unto the said James Iglehart his Executors administrators and
 assigns all and singular the goods and chattels and personal property then
