 the twenty second day of December eighteen hundred and forty two as aforesaid or
 or before the first day of October eighteen hundred and forty four thousand and one thousand
 three presents and every matter and thing therein contained shall be and determine
 and be utterly void to all intents and purposes In witness whereof the said James
 Garrison just hale set his hand and seal the day and year first herein
 before written
