and assigns all his crop of Tobacco and all his interest in and to the crop of
Tobacco which was sown by Emerson Thompson with the land whereon hereunder (the
said being one half of said crop) then sold upon the last section thousand and four
more or less to have and to hold the said crop or crops or parcels of Tobacco
then before granted bargained and sold unto the said Thomas S Hall his
Executors administrators or assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said
Thomas S Hall his Executors administrators and assigns forever provided
always and these presents are upon that condition that the said Samuel
Smith his Executors and administrators shall and do, will and truly pay or
cause to be paid unto the said Thomas S Hall his Executors administrators or
assigns the full sum of one hundred dollars current money with legal interest for the
same or before the first day of any month in the date of these presents then next
in such case these presents shall cease and be utterly void and the said Samuel S
Smith for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the said crops or
parcels of Tobacco by these presents granted bargained and sold unto the said
Thomas S Hall his Executors administrators or assigns against them the said
Samuel Smith his Executors and administrators and against all and every
other person or persons what so ever shall and do warrant and for ever defend
In Witness whereof I the said Samuel Smith do hereby set my hand and affix my
seal the day and year first hereunto before written.
