Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Stallings of Anne Arundel County for and in consideration of Samuel Dove's being my superior and own judgment recovered against me by Robert Stummer for Thirty five dollars with Interest & Costs thereon and in further consideration of my being justly indebted in whole or in part to the said Samuel Dove for fourteen dollars and seventy cents and the additional sum of one dollar to more him paid by the said Samuel Dove at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do here by acknowledge to have granted bargained and sold unto by these presents to grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Dove his Executors administrators and assigns all my share of the crops of Corn and Tobacco now on the farm where I reside three head of sheep & thirteen hogs all which property is now in my possession to have and to hold the same described & properly above bargained and sold to the said Samuel Dove his Executors administrators and assigns to him and their only proper use and benefit And I the said Thomas Stallings for myself my Executors and administrators shall and well warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Samuel Dove his Executors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my Executors and administrators and against all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof provided never the less that in case I the said Thomas Stallings shall pay the several sums before mentioned to Robert Stummer & Samuel Dove aforesaid and bear the said Samuel Dove himself from being my superior then this bill of sale shall utterly void and void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in Law In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1843
