

Chancery his Executors administrators or assigns shall on or before the first day of August in the year eighteen hundred and forty one pay or Cause to be paid to the said James Chaney his Executors administrators or assigns the aforesaid sum of one thousand dollars current money with Interest thereon from the date of these presents then this Indenture and all and everything therein contained shall cease and be utterly void to all intents and purposes anything therein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding
