Cunningham became the purchaser at and for the sum of Seventy dollars current money Now know all men by these presents that I George D. Clayton for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars current money have given granted bargained and sold unto James William Cunningham the said Negro Johnnied Adeline as Witness my hand and seal this day of October 1843

This Indenture made this twentieth day of October in the year eight hundred and forty three between Benjamin Watkins of Ben of Anne Arundel County Maryland of the one part and Samuel Augustus Clagett and Charles Clagett of the said County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Watkins of Ben for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand six hundred and seventy dollars current money hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Augustus Clagett and Charles Clagett and to the survivor of them and to the Executors and administrators of such survivor the following Negroes Slaves to wit: Phillis, Abrubard, George, Hannah Jacob and Rhoda and her three children, also four head of horses, three mule cows and all other live stock household and kitchen
