

This Indenture made this eleventh day of November in the year of our Lord
 eighteen hundred and forty three Between Leonidas Coultter of Anne Arundel County
 and State of Maryland of the one part and Henry Coultter Junior of the County and State
 aforesaid of the other part It Witnesseth that the said Leonidas L Coultter for and in
 consideration of the sum of five dollars current money to him in hand paid the receipt
 whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained and sold
 and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Coultter
 Junior his heirs and assigns all the following property that is to say, one dozen
 mahogany chairs, one pair of side tables, one Lounger, one side board, one English
 carpet, one pair of silver candlesticks and snuffers & tray, one Pier glass, one
 mahogany bureau, one wash stand, one feather bed and mattress, one travelling
 trunk, one Toilet and glass, one Pair of dozen Common chairs, three stones, Jewells
 of Castors, one dining table, one horse fence, shawl & hangings, one Common settle, one
 card table, one linen best table, one New throp, one pair Venetian blinds, one small
 walnut table, three fire boards, two kitchen tables & kitchen utensils, one half
 dozen Common dishes, two tinns, three dozen plates, four dozen knives and forks,
 one Hair Carpet & rods, one double barrel gun for ducks, one double barrel bird
 gun, two bar pitchers, two China pitchers, three stone pitchers, two China pitchers
 one bar kegs, two dozen decanters, one Primmer, one Yankee clock, five demijohns
 six Campfire lamps, four oil lamps In house and To hold the said property above
 mentioned and described unto the said Henry Coultter Junior his heirs and assigns
 in trust to and for the uses intents and purposes that is to say In Trust for the
 said grantor Leonidas L Coultter during his natural life and after his death
 to and for the sole use of the said Helen Coultter her heirs and assigns for ever
 clear of this trust In Witness whereof the said Leonidas Coultter hath hereunto
 subscribed his name and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
