

Know all men by these presents that I John H Weaver of Anne Arundel County for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Charles Hodges of the County and State aforesaid above before the writing & delivery of these presents to the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge to have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Charles Hodges his Executors administrators & assigns my several more about five years ago the same being now in my possession to have and to hold the same described and above bargained and sold to the said Charles Hodges his Executors administrators and assigns and I the said John H Weaver for myself my Executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Charles Hodges his Executors administrators and assigns the said described more against me my Executors and administrators and against all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any interest therein In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 8th day of November Eighteen hundred and forty three.
