 administrators for the payment thereof with Interest as aforesaid And secondly  
 that the said Negro Slaves shall be held and possessed by the said Mary E Boyd  
 for the indemnity of herself and the other parties to the said single bill And  
 thirdly after the payment of the said sum of money to the said James Iglehart  
 with interest as aforesaid that then the said Negro Slaves shall be held by the  
 said Mary E Boyd her Executors administrators or assigns in trust for the  
 children of certain Trimmah I Boyd that is to say the said Henrietta Clark  
 Mary E Boyd, Dennis Boyd, Celestia M Boyd, Violetta I Boyd, Amelia  
 M Boyd, Ellen Jane Boyd and Sarah E Boyd and for their equal use and  
 benefit. In Testimony whereof I the said James Iglehart have hereunto

 eighteen hundred and forty three
