said crop of Tobacco and other the premises I have and John G. Ottara have put the
said Robert M. Doolson in full possession by delivering the same to him the said
Robert M. Doolson at the sealing and delivering of these presents In Witness whereof
I the said John G. Ottara as aforesaid hath hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th
day of November in the year of our Lord eight hundred and forty three

came John G. Ottara before me the subscriber a Justice of the Peace for the County
aforesaid and acknowledged that a certain instrument of writing to be his act and deed
agreed to by the aforesaid and containing therein the act of a public sale of land

Know all men by these presents that I Orlando Hamock of Anne
Arundel County Maryland for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and
sixty three dollars and twenty cents current money of the United States to me
in hand paid by Thomas T. Mezek of the same place, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these
presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas T. Mezek a
negro boy called Robert Steffy supposed to be about eighteen or nineteen
years of age to serve the said Thomas T. Mezek until he arrives to the age of
thirty one years and which said boy I purchased under a mortgage executed
by Joshua Johnson to me on the 30th day of September 1842 which is recorded
in Liber "W S G. N. 2" folio 198 one of the personal deed records of
Anne Arundel County at public sale after being duly advertised and after
the expiration of the term of the purchase mentioned in said mortgage
