This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of January in the year of our
 Lord eight hundred and forty four Between Benjamin Blunt of Anne Arundel
 County & State of Maryland of the one part and Charles Waters of the City of Baltimore
 State aforesaid of the other part Whereas the said Benjamin Blunt owes and stands
 justly indebted to the said Charles Waters in the sum of one hundred and fifty
 dollars Current money and to receive the payment thereof is willing to execute these
 presents And this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Blunt for and
 in consideration of the premises and of the sum of five dollars Current money to him
 in hand paid by the said Charles Waters at and before the sealing and delivery
 of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Charles
 Waters his Executors administrators and assigns all and singular the goods
 furniture and household stuff hereinafter particularly mentioned and expressed that
 is to say one Gray mare, one Gray horse, five head of Cattle, three hogs, twelve
 barrels of Corn in the husk, one horse and, one thousand pounds of Pork, two ploughs
 two feather beds bedsteads and furniture, six chairs and two tables To have and
 to hold with and singular the said goods furniture and household stuff unto the said
 Charles Waters his Executors administrators and assigns to him and their own
 use and behoof forever always and it is declared to be the present and
 meaning of these presents that after the said Benjamin Blunt doth and shall well and
 truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Charles Waters his Executors administrators
 and assigns the full sum of one hundred and fifty dollars Current money with
 legal interest for the same or as before the 10 day of November eight hundred
 and forty four then and in such case these presents and every matter in them
 therein contained shall cease determine and be utterly void to all intents and
 purposes anything hereinafter contained to the contrary notwithstanding and this said
 Benjamin Blunt for himself his heirs Executors administrators or assigns shall and
 will well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Charles Waters his
 Executors administrators or assigns the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars
 Current money together with Interest for the same after the rate aforesaid at such
 times,
