 same unto the said Thomas Brown his executor administrators and assigns
 against me the said Elijah B. Stouck any executor and administrators and
 against all and every other person or persons what so ever shall and well warrant
 and defend by these presents and the said Elijah B. Stouck have put the said
 Thomas Brown in full possession by delivering to him the said woman Brown
 the said Mary to the said woman at the sealing and delivering of these presents in the
 name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold or warranted and intended to
 be,
