This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of March in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four Between William T Green of the one
part and The State of Maryland of the other parts Whereas the said William T Green owes
and stands justly indebted to the said State of Maryland in a large sum of money on
several judgments rendered in Anne Arundel County Court that is to say one judgment
rendered on October Term 1836, another judgment rendered on April Term 1837, one
other judgment rendered on April Term 1839, another judgment rendered on October Term
1840 and one other judgment rendered on April Term 1842 and to secure the payment
thereof the said State of Maryland in such order and on such judgment or judgments
as the certain and lawful Attorney of the said State may direct and appoint and
with legal interest on the said several judgments as the same time or may accrue
Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said William T Green for and in
consideration of the above stated premises for and in consideration of the sum of
five dollars present money to him in hand paid by the State of Maryland out or
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said
William T Green doth hereby acknowledge and therefrom doth acquit
release covenant and forever discharge the said State of Maryland by these presents
both granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain and
sell unto the said State of Maryland all and singular the goods and chattels
tenure after particularly mentioned and expressed, that is to say all my silver plate
and household and kitchen furniture now being in and about my dwelling
house
