Know all men by these presents that I Edward Williams of Anne
 County County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of
 one thousand and four dollars lawful money to me in hand paid by Edith Williams
 of the County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof the said Edward Williams do hereby acknowledge
 have granted bargained and sold unto by these presents do grant bargain and sell
 unto the said Edith Williams her Executors Administrators and assigns the following
 described Negroes, to wit: Myo an named Tom who is a white man for term of years
 and Myo boy named Stephen sometimes called Moss who is also a white man for term
 of years, and Myo boy named Alexander a white man for life, and Myo girl Ellen
 also for life to have and to hold the above named Negroes, as have bargained
 and sold as mentioned and intended to be to the said Edith Williams her
 Executors Administrators and assigns for the use and behoof of said
 Negroes for a term of years and the other for life and I the said Edward
 Williams for myself my heirs Executors and Administrators all and singular the
 said Negroes unto the said Edith Williams her Executors Administrators and
 assigns against me the said Edward Williams my Executors and Administrators
 and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will
 warrant and force defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said
 Edward Williams and Edith Williams have hereunto set our hands and
 seals this fifteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and sixty four
