 Executors and administrators all and singular the said personal property unto
 the said William H Wood his Executors administrators and assigns agreeable
 the said Samuel Sunderland my Executors and administrators may against all
 and every person or persons who shall or will warrant and for ever
 defend by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 appended my seal this seventh day of May eight hundred and forty four

 of the Justices of the peace in and for the State and County aforesaid appeared Samuel
 Sunderland and acknowledged the within instrument of him being to be his act and
 deed and the personal property therein named and hereby conveyed to be the right and
 estate of the within named William H Wood upon the condition therein declared
 and hereby understood as collateral security for the sum of five hundred and
 fifty dollars with the interest thereon and the same to have an indemnity for the same as aforesaid
 and for other purposes according to the tenor and meaning of the same and
 the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided

 confirmation of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars and interest thereon to
 me in hand paid by W^m H Wood of the county and State aforesaid at and for
 the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell
 unto the said William H Wood his Executors his administrators and assigns
 the following property to wit his crop of Tobacco now in the houses of Rich^d Brown
 about eleven thousand pounds more or less to have and to hold the same
