I know all men by these presents that I Sophia Mullock of Anne Arundel and State of Maryland for the consideration of the sum of forty dollars current money to me in hand paid by Simeon Collins of the County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Simeon Collins on his own account a parcel of pine wood standing with the roots to be cut at his expense and by his direction to be measured and when cut to him by two uninterested persons to be named by him the said Simeon Collins and one named by me the said Sophia Mullock the said woods as now standing upon the land therein set to me by the last will and testament of my late husband John Mullock which wood I will warrant and defend to the said Simeon Collins his executors administrators and assigns against me my heirs executors and administrators and against every other person or persons whomsoever.
