Macmillan of the County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and deliver unto the said George W. Macmillan my negro girl "Hester" five years old as at August eighteen hundred and forty four and to serve until she is twenty one years of age I will warrant and defend to the said George W. Macmillan his Executors Administrators and assigns against all my Executors and Administrators and against any other person or persons whomsoever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this second day of May 1864 In presence of Rob^t Boone

Know all men by these presents that I Lundy Lusted of St. Mary's County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and five dollars lawfully owing to me as hereinafter by Alfred Johnson of the County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do hereby grant bargain and sell unto the said Alfred Johnson his Executors Administrators and assigns one negro boy Henry Sturges for life I do hereby hold the said negro boy to the said Alfred Johnson his Executors Administrators and assigns forever and I the said Lundy Lusted for myself my heirs Executors and Administrators the aforesaid negro boy Henry to the said Alfred Johnson his Executors Administrators and assigns against me the said Lundy Lusted my Executors and Administrators and against all and every person or persons whomsoever shall and lawfully do and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I the said Lundy Lusted have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this third day of June 1864
