

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of July in the year eight hundred and forty four Between Gustavus A. Thompson of the City of Minneapolis (my true name is the City of New York) of the County and State of New York also of the City of Minneapolis of the other part. Whereas the said Abraham V. Gannett to her heirs and assigns certain debts and by the said Thompson to A. B. Marvin, William T. Estlin, J. H. Hayes, Messrs Hamilton King and Low, Robert Hyslop & Son, Asa Barns, Sudduth, Frederick Tullog, Slaughter & Company, and S. C. Butler, Henry & Hollins and others amounting in the whole to about the sum of
 And whereas the said Gannett incurred great costs and expenses in procuring the discharge of the said Thompson from his indebtedness to the City of New York by the payment of the debts aforesaid as by other means for all of which the said Thompson is desirous to save and indemnify the said Gannett and for that purpose both agreed to accept these presents. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Gustavus A. Thompson for and in consideration of the premises and for and in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars to him in hand paid by the said Abraham V. Gannett the receipt of which the said Thompson doth hereby acknowledge but he doth hereby grant and deliver unto the said Abraham V. Gannett all the goods wares and merchandise now in his possession and being in the Store and Warehouse on Church Street in the City of Minneapolis where the said Thompson carried on Merchandise and trade consisting of Dry goods Groceries wines liquors, hardware, Boots shoes, Hats Caps, Cloves, glass, broomery now and various other articles and also all the Store fixtures, weights measures, boxes casks &c &c and also all the household and kitchen furniture and every description of personal property of the said Thompson now being in and upon the house and premises lying on West Street in the City of Minneapolis aforesaid and the said Thompson's family man and also all the Crops growing or yet to be raised upon the lands lying on the north side of the City of New York in Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland which the said Thompson purchased of Richard J. Jones and all the right title and interest of the said Thompson and to the same and to the rents issues and profits of the said lands and also all the Stock of horses and Cattle Sheep Hogs Poultry provisions fire wood and other personal property of the said Thompson now on the aforesaid land and premises also all the machinery and horse power now in broad neck and also all the bonds notes open accounts judgments and other choses in action of the said
