This Indenture made this 5th day of October next the year next to come  
between and between Washington by Jack of said Annals County  
with the State of Maryland of the one part and Lewis Tyeing of Howard  
County & State of the other part. Whereas the said Washington by Jack stands  
indebted to the said Tyeing with the sum of one hundred and seven dollars  
and twenty seven cents and is accounted to be with the said Tyeing  
to secure the payment of which the said is executed. Now this Good  
Witnesseth that the said Jack for and in consideration of the premises  
and for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to be paid, to and  
paid by the said Tyeing the receipt of, which he has acknowledged and  
granted he has granted and sold and thereby delayed and bargained and sell  
with the said Lewis Tyeing his Executors administrators and assigns all  
his crop of Tobacco the growth of the year now out and hanging in the  
house or growing in the form of the said Tyeing's Land Rived Nock in the  
said County supposed to contain about fifteen thousand pounds of Tobacco  
more or less to be sold to the said Lewis Tyeing in the hands of the  
Shuff of the said County and the judgment of J. Thomas Bird against the said  
Jack to have and to hold unto the said Tyeing his Executors administrators  
and assigns forever. Provided always and these presents are executed on the  
condition that if the said Jack do and shall well and truly pay the above said
