 and delivery of these presents the receipt, which is hereby acknowledged to me
 by me and sold and by the presents to day and hereafter and sell and to be
 and Butler and Lawrence their executors administrators and assigns all the crop of
 tobacco now in the houses or any farm in Anne Arundel County to have and to hold
 and crop into the said Butler and Lawrence their executors administrators and
 assigns in trust nevertheless that they shall and will do so as to cause any
 be concerned after receipt thereof sell the same crop for the best prices which can be
 obtained for the same and the net proceeds thereof to apply to the payment of the
 monies now due or which at the time of sale may be due from the said
 Butler and Lawrence and the residue of such proceeds if any to pay over to me my
 executors administrators or assigns and for myself my heirs executors and
 administrators I do hereby Covenant and agree to receive with the said Butler
 and Lawrence that I and they will discharge all concerns disputed and not any and
 their proper charge and costs strip park and pursue and to cause for a number
 and to be the same to the City of Baltimore to assign to the said Butler and Lawrence
 for the purpose of sale as aforesaid in witness whereof I do hereby set my
 hand and seal this nineteenth day of October in the year eighteen hundred and
 forty four
