A. County To have and To hold the said described Negro Children to the said D^r Mich^l Pue his Executor administrators and assigns forever and the said George Dorsey for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the said Negro Children unto the said Mich^l Pue his Executors administrators and assigns against them the said George Dorsey his Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will do want and for ever defend by these presents In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this ninth day of May (one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine) Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of
