County in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of seven
hundred and seventy five dollars lawfully to me paid by Thomas J
Price and John Price of the aforesaid County in the said State at and before the
writing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I the said William Watts
do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold unto by these presents do
grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas J Price and John Price their
executors administrators and assigns the following negroes to wit: one negro
man named Harvest aged about 30 years and his two sons George aged about
13 years and Lewis aged about 3 years all now singularly and severally me
now with the property of the said Thomas J Price and John Price to have and to
hold all and singular the said negroes above bargained and sold or mentioned
and intimated so to hold to the said Thomas J Price and John Price their executors
administrators and assigns forever and I the said William Watts for myself my
heirs executors and administrators all unto singularly the said negroes unto the said
Thomas J Price and John Price their executors administrators and assigns against
me the said William Watts my executors and administrators or against all and
every other person or persons whatsoever shall and lawfully in any way or
by these presents of me and singularly which said negroes I the said William Watts
have put the said Thomas J Price and John Price and their property by delivery
to the said Thomas J Price and John Price and their property by delivery and
delivery of these presents and their own of the said negroes to be bargained and sold
or mentioned and intimated to be to the said Thomas J Price and John Price
as aforesaid. I the said William Watts had heretofore set his
hand and seal this tenth day of October one thousand eight hundred
and forty four
