by these presents do give and bargain and sell unto the said James Wood his Executors  
administrators and assigns one Bay house one block one third one eighth and one  
lot of Tobacco in the house and contents of the store at which property is  
now in my possession to have and to hold the same unto the said property above  
bargained and sold to the said James Wood his Executors administrators and  
assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the said  
George W Wood for myself my Executors and administrators shall and lawfully  
warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said James Wood his  
Executors administrators and assigns the said described property against  
every Executor and administrator and against all and every other person  
or persons who hereafter claiming the same on any pretence of In Witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the sixth day of  
November eight hundred and forty four.
