 chattels herein after set forth that is to say: One Negro man: Ben is aged about
 thirty four or forty years, Negro man George aged about twenty five years,
 Sam aged about twenty five years, William aged about eighteen years,
 Joseph aged about ten years, Negro woman Harriet aged about thirty years
 Betty aged about thirty five years, Negro girl Mitty aged about ten
 years, Negro boy Jeph & Jey aged about four years, boy Wesley aged about
 six years, girl Fifi aged about twenty years, sundrous ten or nine light
 brown spotted hind of young Cattle and a crop of Tobacco with sundry property
 goods, chattels now in the premises aforesaid and occupied by the said John S.
 Antwine and Arundel County aforesaid. In have and do hold unto and
 conveyed the said goods chattels & property aforesaid & sold consent to
 be bargain and sold to the said John Hunt his Executors Administrators and
 assigns forever and the said John S. Antwine for any self his heirs Executors
 and Administrators all and singular the here mentioned goods chattels & property
 unto the said John Hunt his Executors Administrators and assigns against
 the said John S. Antwine his Executors Administrators and assigns all and
 every other person whatsoever shall and lawfully demand and for ever defend by the
 presents of all and singular the said goods chattels & property. I shew and John S.
 Antwine the said John Hunt have put in full possession by delivering to him
 the said John Hunt a bundle of Tobacco with the sum of the whole property &
 chattels hereby bargain and sold. In Witness whereof I the said John S. Antwine
 have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal with the twenty fourth day of
 December Eighteen hundred and forty four.
