This Indenture made this sixteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Gardner Green of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland of the one part and William McLaughlin of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Gardner Green for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and six dollars current money to him where paid by the said William McLaughlin at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents to the receipt whereof the said Gardner Green doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William McLaughlin his executors administrators and assigns all the goods household stuff and furniture herein after expressed that is to say one bay packing house about fifteen hands high switch tail and a stall in his flock yard two beds two beasteads one dozen chairs one settle one stone hearth of shovel and tongs one pair and various one dozen wine glasses one foot stool and crockery ware tubs and barrels all of which goods household stuff and furniture are now in the possession of the said Gardner Green to have and to hold all and singular the goods and furniture above described unto the said William McLaughlin his executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Gardner Green for himself his heirs executors and administrators the said goods and household stuff unto the said William McLaughlin his executors administrators and assigns against him the said Gardner Green his executors and administrators and against all other persons whatsoever shall send will warrant and forever defend by these presents of all which goods and household stuff the said Gardner Green has put the said William McLaughlin in full possession by delivering to the said William McLaughlin one chair in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold to the said William McLaughlin as aforesaid.
