This Indenture made this twenty second day of November in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine by and between
 Ambrose B Owens of Anno Arundel County and State of Maryland
 of the one part and Edward P Hayden and William J Timanus of the
 County and State of aforesaid trustees as hereafter mentioned of the
 other part. Whereas the said Ambrose B Owens is indebted unto
 various persons in divers sums of money and being unable to pay
 the whole of such debts has proposed and agreed to assign all his

 same unto the said Edward P Hayden and William J Timanus their
 Executors Administrators and assigns upon trust that they or the survivor
 of them and the Executors or Administrators of such survivor do and shall
