


Whereof the said Job Guest and the said John Selby have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals this 15<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty.

Bill of Sale or instrument of writing to be that respective act and deed for the  
purposes therein mentioned according to the true intent and meaning

presents that James Booth Jr. of the said State as aforesaid & Calvert  
Co for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty dollars current money to me in  
hand paid, by James Booth Jr. of the Co of Anne Arundel & State aforesaid  
at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the Receipt Whereof I do  
hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these  
presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said James Booth Jr. my  
father his executors administrators and assigns one Bay horse less  
than seven years old which I bought of James Woods of Calvert County  
at six months for the aforesaid sum of Sixty Dollars and for the payment  
of which sum my father James Booth Jr. is bound as security on my  
Bond to said Mr. Woods to have and to hold the same described  
property above bargained and sold to the said James Booth Jr. His  
executors administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper  
use and benefit and the said James Booth Jr. for myself my executors  
and
