Know all men by these presents that we Benjamin Richardson and Sophia  
Richardson of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland in consideration  
of the sum of Four hundred Dollars to them wher paid by Richard Green of  
Harford County and State aforesaid doth receipt of which whereby acknowledged  
granted bargained and sold unto the said Richard the following goods  
and chattels to wit One Horse, one Cow, one yearling Cow a one horse  
Waggon four beds and bedding two mahogany tables one black Walnut  
Bureau four bedsteads and dozen Chairs and all the farming utensils  
now in possession of said Benjamin and Sophia Richardson and we do  
hereby fully convey and assign the same to the said Richard Green Provided  
always that if the said Benjamin and Sophia shall owe or before the first  
day of January eighteen hundred and forty two cause to be paid or pay  
to the said Richard the sum of four hundred Dollars with interest  
from the fifth day of October eighteen hundred and thirty two then these  
presents to be null and void otherwise to be and remain in full force and  
virtue in law In testimony whereof the said Benjamin Richardson and  
Sophia hath here set their hands and seals this twenty first day of  
January eighteen hundred and forty two
