Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in Consideration of the
Sum of Two hundred Dollar lawful money of the United States in hand
paid by Thomas Moller of Baltimore City Free Coloured man at or before
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Moller his Executors
administrators and assigns one Coloured girl named Mary Ann Miller
Born on the 17th day of October 1822, and another Coloured Girl named
Ellen Miller Born on the 7th day of October 1824 both girls being the
Children of the said Thomas Moller To have and to hold the said
described Coloured Girls to the said Thomas Moller his Executors administrators
and assigns forever and I the said Sally B Sudler for myself my heirs
Executors and administrators the said Coloured Girls unto the said Thomas
Moller his Executors administrators and assigns, against me the said
Sally B Sudler my Executors and administrators and against all
and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and well warrant
and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this day of Eighteen hundred and
forty
