 person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend
 by these presents of all and singular which said household furniture and
 other the premises of the said James D^r Wrens, have put the said James
 Ogilhart in full possession by delivering to him the said James Ogilhart
 one towel at the sealing and delivery of these presents in the name of the
 whole premises hereby bargained and sold or mentioned and intended
 to be so unto him the said James Ogilhart as aforesaid In Testimony
 whereof the said James D^r Wrens have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this twenty fourth day of April in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred & forty
