Hodges his executors administrators and assigns three negro boys hereinafter more particularly described, namely John who was nine years of age on the seventh day of August last. Isaac alias Isaac who was six years of age on the sixteenth day of Feb. last Elias who was four years of age on the twelfth day of July last sons of a certain negro woman Maria who with her increase was manumitted by deed from the said Nachel Sevier dated the fourth day of January eighteen hundred and thirty two the said Maria to remain in servitude until the fourth day of January eighteen hundred and thirty two the said Maria to remain in servitude until the fourth day of January eighteen hundred and forty two</p>
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
