 have and to hold unto the said Whittington and Snyder their Executors
 administrators and assigns forever to and for their only use and behoof
 and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever Provided
 Nevertheless that if the Francis Brashear his Executors administrators
 or assigns shall and do well and truly saw hereunto and indemonstrate
 the said Whittington and Snyder their Executors administrators and
 assigns from all loss and damage by reason of their acceptance as
 aforesaid then these presents and every matter and thing therein
 set forth shall be utterly null and void and of none effect.
