 to the said James P. Gray his executors administrators and assigns
 the said described property against me my executors and administrators
 and against all and every other person or persons who or we claim
 the same in any part thereof Provided nevertheless that in case
 the said John G. O'Hara shall pay and satisfy unto the said James
 P. Gray or to his executors administrators or assigns the said sum
 of three hundred and eighty three dollars and sixty six cents on or
 before the fourth day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixty
 nine then this bill of sale and every matter and thing therein
 expressed shall be void and of no effect it being the true intent
 and meaning thereof that the said property is mortgaged by me the
 said John G. O'Hara to secure to the said James P. Gray the payment
