 under the name style and firm of John Sullivan & Sons do agree
 to execute this instrument of writing as a full release of the above
 mentioned crops of tobacco and corn and the aforesaid mentioned
 negro men. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said
 John Sullivan Henry Sullivan and Francis Sullivan trading
 as aforesaid under the name style and firm of John Sullivan & Sons
 for and in consideration of the payment of the above mentioned
 sum of money and the interest thereon and in consideration
 of the sum of ten dollars current money to them in hand paid
 by the said Samuel Augustus Clagett and Charles Clagett the
 receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and themselves to be
 fully satisfied contented and paid have and by these presents do
 grant bargain and sell and release unto them the said Samuel
 Augustus Clagett and Charles Clagett their executors administrators
 and assigns forever so much of the above described
 crops of tobacco and corn as remain unsold and all the aforesaid
 named negro men to them the said Samuel Augustus Clagett
 and Charles Clagett their executors administrators and assigns
 respectively of their several interest therein forever to their only
 proper use and behoof and to and for no other use or purpose
 whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said John Sullivan Henry
 Sullivan and Francis Sullivan have hereunto set their hands
