



Thos. E. Burk at or before the making and delivery of these presents

 & more and three Hogs. To Have and To Hold the property aforesaid to
 the said property H. B. Darnall his Executors administrators and assigns
 forever and I the said Thos. E. Burk for myself my heirs Executors
 and administrators as aforesaid the said property to the said H. B. Dar-
 nall his Executors administrators and assigns against me the said
 Thos. E. Burk my Executors and administrators and against all
 and every person and persons whomsoever shall and will now and
 hereafter depend by these presents. Provided nevertheless that in
 case I the said Thos. E. Burk shall pay and satisfy the said Thos. B. Darnall
 or his Executors administrators and assigns the sum of fifty dollars current
 money with the interest for the same then due on or before the 15th day of
 Aug^r 1848 then this bill of sale and every matter and thing therein
 expressed shall be void and null and of no effect I the said Thos. E.
 Burk intending thereby that the property aforesaid is mortga-
 ged by me the said Thos. E. Burk to secure the rents due as collateral
 security the payment of fifty dollars and interest as aforesaid. In
 witness whereof I the said Thos. E. Burk have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal the tenth day of August in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and forty six


