Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Daniel McBall for and in consideration of the premises and of the sum of five dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said Enoch Duwall at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Enoch Duwall his executors administrators and assigns all and singular the goods furniture and household stuff herein after particularly mentioned and expressed that is to say two beds bedsteads and furniture one bureau one looking glass two silver watches one Gun and one box of tools together with all the household and kitchen furniture of whatsoever kind the same or any comes also one Horse and one cow. To Have and To Hold all and singular the said goods furniture and household stuff unto the said Enoch Duwall his executors administrators and assigns to his and their own use and behoof. Provided always and it is declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said Daniel McBall do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Enoch Duwall his executors administrators or assigns the full sum of two hundred dollars current money with legal interest for the same then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing herein contained shall cease determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
