 the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said
 John E. Pettibone his Executors administrators and assigns one negro
 man named Peter Anderson to serve until the ~~second~~ day of August
 in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty three and then to
 be free and also one negro man named William H. Addison to serve
 until the sixteenth day of April in the year one thousand eight
 hundred and fifty and then to be free. To Have and To Hold the said
 negroes above named to the said John E. Pettibone his Executors admini-
 strators and assigns until the periods above limited in that respect.
