executors administrators and assigns all the goods household stuff
implements and furniture herein after particularly mentioned
that is to say two feather beds one bedstead one sofa one side
board one couch three chairs one stone two iron pots one tea
kettle one pair of hand irons one skillet and one wooden clock
two looking glasses one gilded picture frame one rag carpet wood
horse and saw and one axe &c &c all and every such which said goods
and chattels are now remaining standing and being in a certain
messuage or tenement situate in the City of Annapolis and now
in the joint occupation of the said William Greenwell and Thomas
T. Terry. To Have and To Hold all and singular the said goods household
stuff and furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold
or mentioned and intended so to be to the said Thomas T. Terry his Executors
administrators and assigns forever and the said William Greenwell
for myself my heirs executors and administrators all and singular
the said goods household stuff and furniture and other the premises
unto the said Thomas T. Terry his Executors administrators and assigns
against me the said William Greenwell my executors and administrators
and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will
warrant and forever defend by these presents of all and singular which
said goods household stuff and furniture and other the premises the
said William Greenwell have put the said Thomas T. Terry in full
