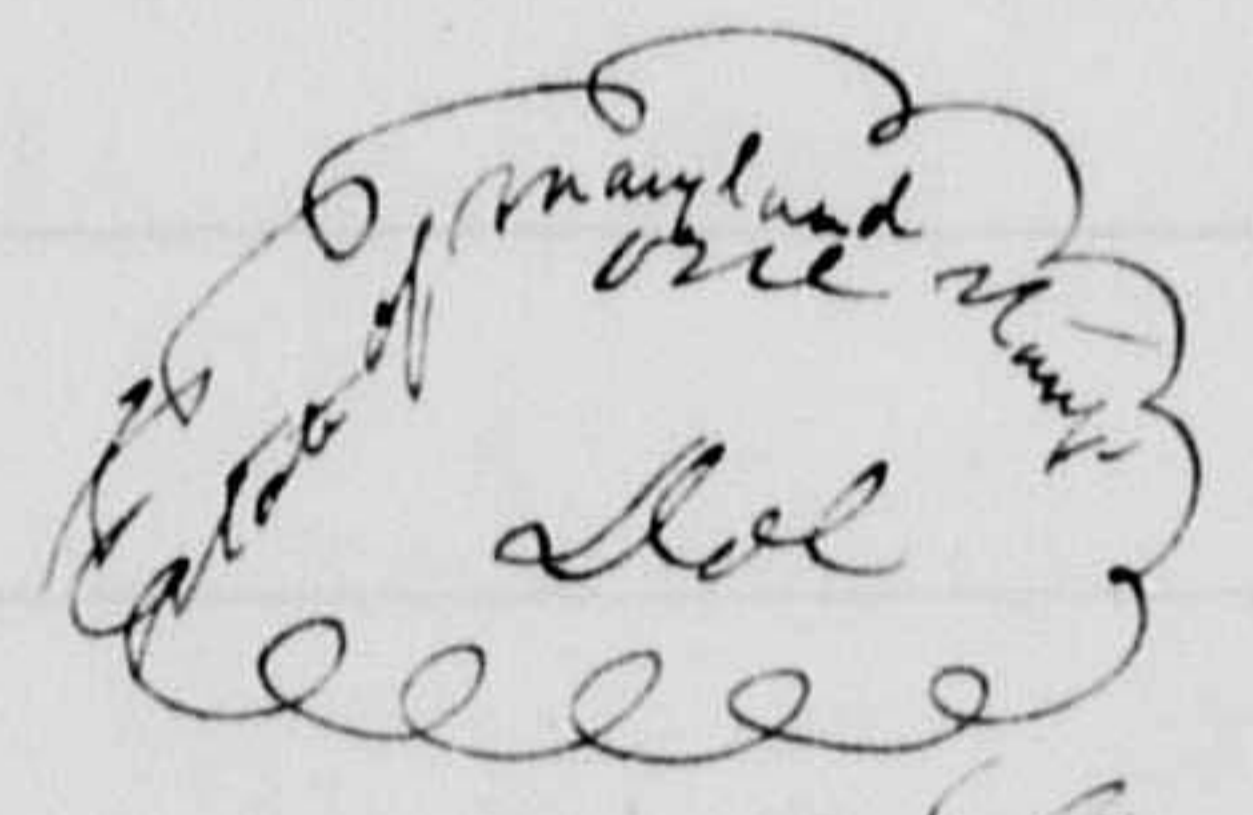

Williams of the County and State aforesaid at and before the reading and delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry A. Williams his Executors administrators and assigns my negro man James which I bought of Samuel S. Lynch administrator of my late husband Richard A. Hinchcomb which property is now in my possession. To have and to hold the same described property above designated and sold to the said Henry A. Williams his Executors administrators and assigns forever to his and their only proper use and benefit. And I the said Margaret Hinchcomb for myself my Executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Henry A. Williams his Executors administrators and assigns the said described property against me my Executors administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty first day of December eighteen hundred and forty six.
