two hundred dollars current money of Maryland to me in hand paid by James Turner a free coloured man of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said James Turner a negro woman named Rebecca about forty two years old and wife of the said James Turner and her four children named Mary about six years old one named Dennis about four years old one named James about two years old and one named Len about four months old which negro woman Rebecca and her four children as above named shall remain and depend to the said James Turner his Executors administrators and assigns against me my Executors and administrators and against every other person or persons whomsoever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this thirty first day of December eighteen hundred and forty six
